Golf Tips

Jack Nicklaus said, "Success depends almost entirely on how effectively you learn to manage the game's two ultimate adversaries: the course and yourself."

As we continue to prepare for the 99th Edition of the Tannahill Shield, it is good to ensure that we are in tip top condition: Physically and mentally.

We all know that the right mindset means half the job is done, the rest will just follow. Here's how you can ensure that your mind is clear, and your physical health is in check:

Nutrition:

Prioritize balanced meals that include a mix of carbohydrates, protein, healthy fats, fruits, and vegetables. Opt for complex carbohydrates like whole grains, fruits, and vegetables, which provide sustained energy throughout the round. Choose lean sources of protein such as chicken, fish, tofu, or legumes to support muscle repair and recovery. Avoid heavy, greasy foods that can lead to sluggishness and discomfort during play.

Pack healthy snacks like nuts, seeds, fruit, or energy bars to fuel up between rounds or during breaks.

It is important to consider the timing of meals to avoid feeling too full or hungry during play; aim to eat a balanced meal 2-3 hours before teeing off.

Hydration:

Stay well-hydrated before, during, and after the tournament to maintain optimal performance and concentration. Drink water consistently throughout the day leading up to the tournament to ensure proper hydration. Bring a refillable water bottle and sip water regularly during the round, especially in hot or humid conditions.

Avoid excessive caffeine and alcohol consumption, as they can contribute to dehydration. Consider incorporating electrolyte-rich beverages or sports drinks to replenish lost fluids and minerals, particularly during long rounds or in high heat.

Rest and Recovery:

Prioritize getting adequate rest in the days leading up to the tournament to ensure your body is well-rested and ready for play. Aim for 7-9 hours of quality sleep each night to support physical and mental recovery.

Avoid overtraining or intensive practice sessions immediately before the tournament, as this can lead to fatigue and decreased performance.

Incorporate active recovery activities such as light stretching, yoga, or gentle walks to promote circulation and relaxation.

Listen to your body and prioritize rest if you're feeling fatigued or sore; pushing through exhaustion can increase the risk of injury and hinder performance on the course.

By focusing on nutrition, hydration, and rest, golfers can optimize their physical and mental readiness for tournament play, ensuring they perform at their best throughout the event.

Ladies Changing Rooms

I am pleased to announce The Project is 100% Complete! The official Handing Over ceremony was done by the Chairman, Royal Nairobi Golf Club on Thursday 7th March, 2024 in a colorful event that attended by Board members, The Project Committee, Members and Staff. We would like to thank everyone involved in the success of this project, especially Dr. Rachel Njuguna who was there every step of the way, giving us her invaluable input and ensuring that the Ladies had a changing room suited to their needs.



Relocation of Accounts Department

The process of relocating the Accounts office is currently underway. I would like to report progress is being made. An I.T Contractor has been engaged to facilitate the transition and we anticipate their work to commence at the earliest opportunity. Our team is committed to meeting the established deadline. your patience and understanding during this period of transition is highly appreciated.

KPLC Transformer

In our continued efforts to improve infrastructure and efficiency, a proposal was submitted for the installation of a transformer in our premises. We have received a quotation for Ksh.3.7M/= which aligns with our budgetary considerations.

Additionally, there has been a proposal to look into solar energy as an alternative power source. This initiative aims to not only reduce our environmental footprint, but

also provide a sustainable solution for our energy needs. A letter of Expression was sent to interested bidders and we will keep you updated on progress.

Dam No. 15 Outlet

The excavation process had begun and culverts were fixed and backfilled. Further excavations to the areas that needed manual labor have begun as well. The Contractor has been requested to add manpower to aid in completing the work as soon as possible.

Water Pump:

An update from the technician stated that the outstanding balance for the two motors is Ksh.189,000/=. They requested for an upfront payment of Ksh.94,500/= to cater to repairs, as well as to bring and test the pump.

As we move forward with these projects, your support and cooperation are invaluable to us. Please rest assured that we are committed to delivering the best possible outcomes for our members and the club as a whole.
